## OBJECTIVES:

- To engage the kids in activities that they find both enjoyable and meaningful
- To give them an opportunity to learn and develop skills like Painting, Craftwork, Dance, etc.
- To provide an even platform for all kids to explore and express their creativity, in any form
- To educate and create awareness among them about various issues like the Environment, Nutrition, etc.

## CAMP DURATION:

The camp kicked off on the 05<sup>th</sup> of April 2022, and we concluded on the 10<sup>th</sup> of April 2022. The intra-day duration was from 09:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on all days. The Camp was inaugurated on 05<sup>th</sup> April 2022 in Government High School, Meenakaliya, Baikampady, Mangalore – 575010 by our own Tulu Nadu Movie Actor and Director Sri Sai Krishna Kudla and showered his words of encouragement to CHAMARA® Foundation. ## DETAILS OF CONDUCTED ACTIVITIES:

### 1. ART & CRAFT:

In keeping with the theme of Creativity, Painting, Poster Making, and Sketching, Students found ideas, activities, crafts and colouring pages that gave lots of fun and excitement at summer camp. They learnt how to make cool crafts using recycled materials, create critters from natural objects, make beads, mix up cave paint and much more!



This activity helped the students develop their bilateral coordination, and fine motor skills, promote their artistic efforts, improve visual processing skills and promote executive functioning.

### 2. YAKSHAGANA, DANCE, MIME AND MUSIC:

Yakshagana, Mime Shows, Music and dance are great stress removers. Music is the shorthand of emotion and dancers are the messengers of the gods. Classical Contemporary, Western, Hip hop dance forms, Yakhagana basics, Mime show and Common musical forms were introduced to the students.





This activity helped our Children in having loads of fun. It allowed them to stay active in a fun and exciting way. All the while, the kids developed important social and emotional skills without even realizing it.

### **3. YOGA:**

Yoga develops physical and mental health. Yoga means the addition of energy, strength and beauty of body, mind and soul. Notwithstanding the fact that the school was observing summer vacation, a total of 150 students took part in the session. The students were educated on the importance of Yoga. They explained that yoga helps in maintaining not only physical and mental health but also healthy social life. The students were taught various Aasanas starting with warming up and stretching followed by the series of Padmasana, Paschimottasans, Pawan Muktasana, Vajrasana

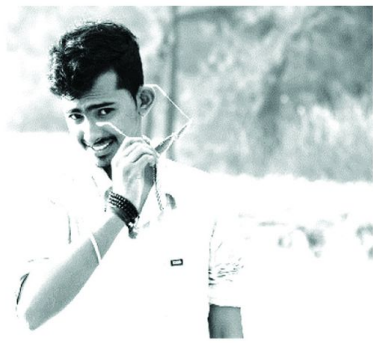

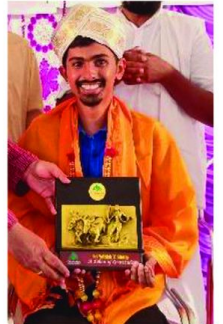
